What is Pupil Premium?



Pupil Premium is funding given to schools for the specific purpose of boosting the attainment of pupils from low-income families.

Funding is based on children who have registered for a free school meal at any point in the last 6 years, children that are in care or adopted and children whose parents are currently serving in the armed forces.

If you believe your child is eligible for this funding, please ask the office for a form.

How are we spending the Money at Sheerhatch Primary School?

Additional Teaching Assistant who works across both sites with the children in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant.

Helping to fund enrichment activities and resources.

Support with provision of uniform/care club where necessary.

Family support worker who works with children fortnightly. She also supports families too.

Extra training for teaching staff to keep up to date with curriculum research and changes.

We have developed a list of key experiences that we would like all our pupils to benefit from and facilitate these for our vulnerable pupils. These included unique and important activities such as: build a den, care for a pet or speak another language!
